## THE ROSERY HOTEL - CHURCH STREET - EXNING - CB8 7EH

This hotel is a peach coloured building situated between Newmarket and Burwell.

From Newmarket town take the Exning Road which eventually goes under the A14 and becomes Church Street, Exning and the building can be found on the left side of the road just beyond Wests Garage and opposite Beechwood Close.

From Ely take the A142 along the Soham/Fordham Bypass and turn right towards Newmarket and as you reach the roundabout just past the Equine Research Building turn right and take the Landwade Road between Turners Depot and DS Smith depot. This is a lovely, quiet road passing cottages and a few houses which changes its name to Cotton End Road in Exning. You can see the hotel from the junction with Windmill Hill and the entrance to the car park is through the arch in the wall.

If you would rather continue on the A142 towards Newmarket you need to turn right onto Windmill Hill (signposted Exning) just before the A14 junction exit slip roads which are very busy. This road will take you to another junction on a bend, turn left and the hotel is just a few metres along on the right hand side of the road.

If the hotel car park is full you can park on the roadside on Church Road or in Beechwood Close opposite the hotel.

The entrance to the Restaurant is through an archway and down a sloping pathway with no steps.

From the A11 Norwich or A14 Bury take the exit slip road (J37) and you may find it easier and quicker to turn left and go to the roundabout (Homebase) and there turn right onto the A142 back over the A14 and take the first exit to Exning and along Windmill Hill to the hotel.

From Cambridge or the A11 take the exit for A142 Ely at J37 turn left and after a few metres turn left onto the road for Exning and along Windmill Hill to the hotel.

I need to remind you that if you come along and need to cancel your booking before the RSVP date (1<sup>st</sup> May) then I can refund you but cancellation after that date refunds will not be possible.
